C. Qualification Overview

Purpose:

The development of an Advanced Emergency First Aid skills programme in South Africa is necessary to improve the quality of emergency first aid care provided to patients in various settings, including workplaces, schools, and public places.

Learners who complete the Advanced Emergency First Aid Responders will obtain several specific benefits, including:

- Providing learners with advanced first aid knowledge and skills in emergency medical care. This includes training in resuscitation techniques and the management of trauma.
- Increased confidence in their ability to provide emergency first aid care in a variety of settings, including workplaces, schools, and public places.

D. Exit Level Outcomes.

- Apply advanced emergency first aid requirements to manage the activities of first aid providers on an emergency scene.
- Apply advanced first aid techniques to manage specific life-threatening conditions caused by trauma or medical emergencies
- Apply ethical and procedural principles to conduct secondary patient assessments, determine and provide further required first aid care techniques.
- Apply legal and ethical process, to hand over affected persons appropriately and complete post treatment procedures.
